What we actively engage in to sustaining the environment:

- Several of our trips are designed to start and finish in Bergen city centre, eliminating the need for additional transportation.
- NMG offer "Green Discount" for participants arriving at our courses/trips via public transportation (bus/train).
- Waste Collection We engage in litter cleanup activities, involving our guests and providing them with waste bags for responsible disposal.

- Guest Education We provide teaching of our guests on the importance of protecting vulnerable ecosystems.
- We emphasize the reuse of various products, such as second-hand skis from thrift stores like Fretex and other environmental stations, to avoid unnecessary production. Despite potential cost savings through sponsorships, we willingly pay more for used products to promote sustainability.
